The Department of Digital Systems at the University of Piraeus is currently accepting applications for enrollment in the Graduate Program (M.Sc.) in "Information Systems & Services" (Starting in October 2024). The M.Sc. program offers a Master's Degree with specializations in the following areas:

- ◆ **Advanced Information Systems,**
- ◆ **Big Data and Analytics, ΚΑΔ**
- ◆ **IT Governance.**

The aforementioned M.Sc. program accepts graduates from domestic higher education institutions (universities and technological institutes) or equivalent institutions abroad.

Candidate selection is based on objective criteria and a personal interview conducted by a committee of faculty members of the Department.

Part of the M.Sc. program may be conducted remotely in accordance with prevailing regulations.

Applications are accepted **from April 8th, 2024, until ~~May 31st~~ July 21st, 2024.**

Interested individuals are required to submit the following documents:

- Application for candidacy.
- Detailed curriculum vitae.
- Copies of academic degrees or other credentials (e.g., completion certificates) demonstrating graduation.
- Detailed transcripts (one for each degree).
- Certified proof of proficiency in English.
- Certified proof of sufficient knowledge of the Greek language (for foreign candidates).
- Certificates and other evidence of professional and research activities (if available).
- Two (2) letters of recommendation.
- Photocopies of any scientific works and publications (in three [3] copies).
- Photocopy of both sides of the identity card.

- One (1) photograph.
- Affidavit (through the service <https://www.gov.gr/ipiresies/polites-kai-kathemerinoteta/upeuthune-delose-kai-exousiodotese> or with certification of genuine signature at a Citizen Service Center (KEP) or Police Station in Greece) declaring by the candidate that the submitted documents in their folder are authentic."
